2018 GOLF RULES AND REGULATIONS

To insure that your event at Grassy Hill Country Club will be a pleasant experience, we direct your attention to certain rules and regulations that apply to guests and visitors. We hope that by advising you of these rules in advance of your visit, any possible embarrassment will be avoided.

CLEANLINESS

To help preserve the golf course please dispose of all litter in trash containers.

GOLF COURSE

Please rake bunkers, fix ball marks and replace all divots. Keep golf carts on paths and obey all other golf cart signs and directions. Always hit from between the tee markers and please do not remove the ball from the cup with the putter head. There is no practicing allowed on the course.

SPEED of PLAY

USGA Rules allow five minutes to look for a lost ball, please don't waste your time and others. If there is an open hole in front of you, your foursome is playing too slowly. Please try to keep pace with the group in front of you.

DRESS

Proper attire, such as collared shirts and tailored shorts/pants must be worn on the Golf Course and in the Club house. Proper attire specifically excludes the wearing of "short shorts", cut-offs, running shorts, jeans, T-shirts or tank tops. Management and the pro shop staff have been instructed to prohibit improperly attired players from using the golf course.

NO METAL SPIKES

Soft spikes are required to be worn on the golf course and club house. The pro shop is equipped to replace all metal spikes. If metal spikes are worn while on the golf course you will be asked to leave the course until soft spikes are installed.

HARASSMENT

Boisterous and/or profane language will not be permitted anywhere on club property. Abusive treatment of staff members will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Such conduct will be reported to management and disciplinary action will be taken.

Management reserves the right to ask the violators to leave the premises. Should a guest, at any time, have due concern for the conduct of a staff member, management should be notified immediately.

2018 GOLF RULES AND REGULATIONS (CONT.)

PARKING

Parking is permitted only in lined parking spaces provided. No vehicles will be allowed to park either in front of the dumpster or on a cart path. The parking has been designed to accommodate all guests; while following the codes of the town. Guests must abide by parking regulations by honoring reserved spaces and by parking vehicles in lined areas only. Management reserves the right to tow vehicles, that are not parked properly, at the owners expense.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

The club is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.

ALCOHOL POLICY

Drinking alcoholic beverages in the parking lot is prohibited. Players, volunteers and/or guests under the age of 21 will not be served and are not permitted to drink alcohol on the club's premises. The legal drinking age is 21, and we will not tolerate practices responsible serving practices. We will refuse service to any intoxicated player, volunteer and/or guest. We will always show respect for the individual so as to minimize embarrassment, and our servers should be treated in the same fashion.

BEVERAGE COOLER

Beverage coolers are prohibited on golf carts and on the course. The pro shop staff has been instructed to remove all coolers from the course. Your cooperation is appreciated.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are mandatory for all players. Neither the use of pull carts nor the carrying of clubs is permitted. Also, you must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid drivers license to operate a golf cart. No more than two persons are permitted in or on a golf cart at any time. Tampering with the golf carts is not permitted (e.g. changing the governor). Management reserves the right to ask the violators to leave the premises.

CART SIGNS AND ROPES

No golf carts are to be driven past the marked areas on the course by cart signs and/or ropes. These areas are around greens, streams, ponds, ground under repair and dangerous areas as determined by the Head Superintendent.
